Open a Clickbank Account and Upload a Wordpress Blog Using the FTP Client Filezilla


Before we go any further I want you to create a free account at Clickbank.com, what this enables you to do is earn money as an affiliate (someone who promotes other peoples products for a commission), this is how you monetise your blog for profit !

Now if you have never heard of Clickbank, don't worry I will provide a link at the end of the report to their site, but basicily you the affiliate promote a vendors (sellers) products for whatever % the vendor puts on a sales commission?


On average its 50%, so if you promote and sell a product for say \$ 47 you will receive half that amount in commission,so you can go check it out, browse it get a feel for it , find out in more detail how this system and Clickbank works?

Very important this section of the sign up his your nickname, in other words its the name of the account so choose a name you can remember, it's part of your log in details!

Tick box, then submit!

You have have just created your very own Clickbank account so now you can monetise your blog as an affiliate!

Now moving on , in the next step we need to use an FTP client, (**F**ile **T**ransfer **P**rotocol), basically this is a procedure where you transfer any and all files to your web space (hosting account) from anywhere on your PC, and in this report we will be using an FTP client to transfer all the necessary files for creating your Wordpress blog, making it live on the internet!

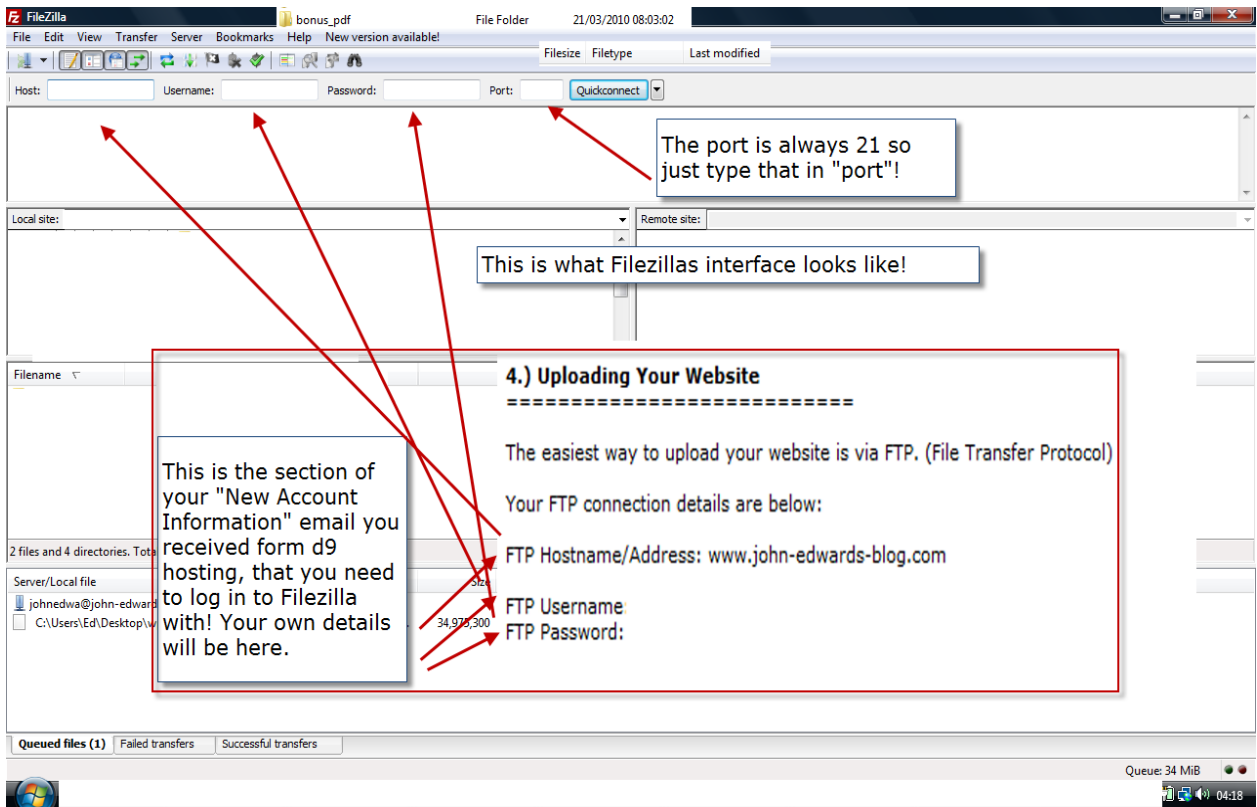
Now an FTP client is software that kind of acts as an middleman between your PC and the internet, you will see more clearly what I mean when we go to the screentaps, now the FTP client I use and highly recommend is a free software application called "Filezilla", and in my opinion is the best out there, so lets download and install it..

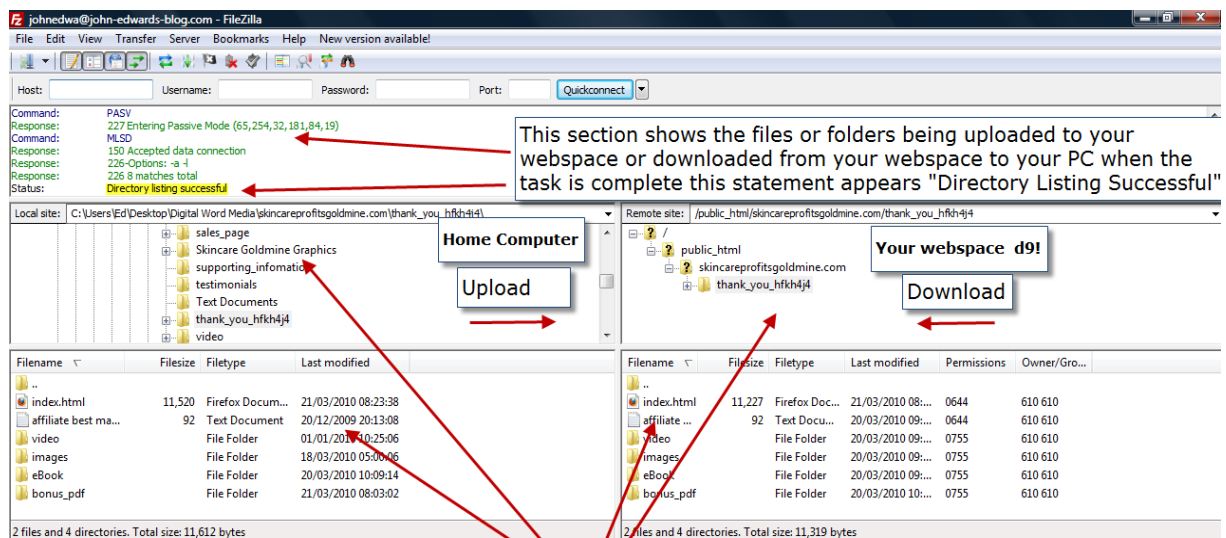

Now here's a tip, always copy and paste your log in details into the boxes, that way the log in will be 100% successful!

Lets take a look at the filezilla interface..



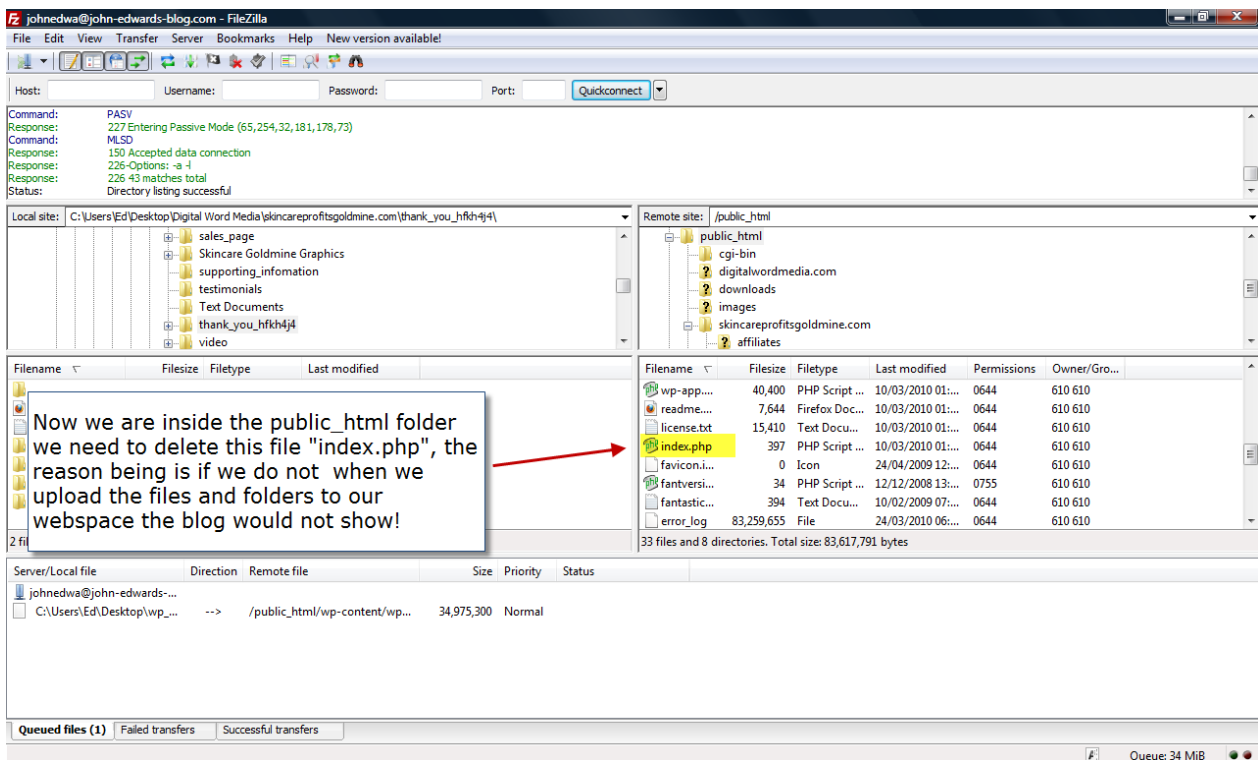
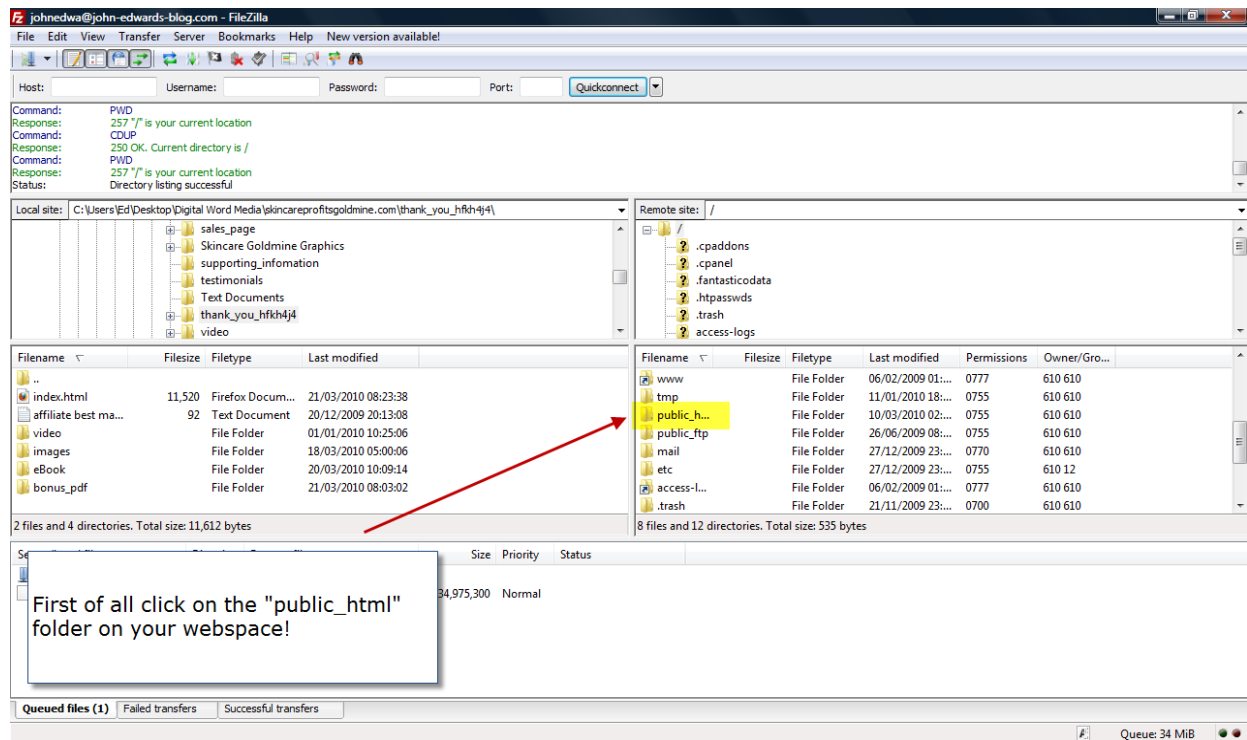
Now you notice there are two sections to filezilla, the left hand box is all the files and folders you have stored on your PC, the right hand box is your webspace at d9 hosting!

So if you wanted to upload any file or folder to your webspace, you would right click on the chosen file or folder on your PC then click on "upload" it will then transfer the file or folder to your webspace on the right making it live online!

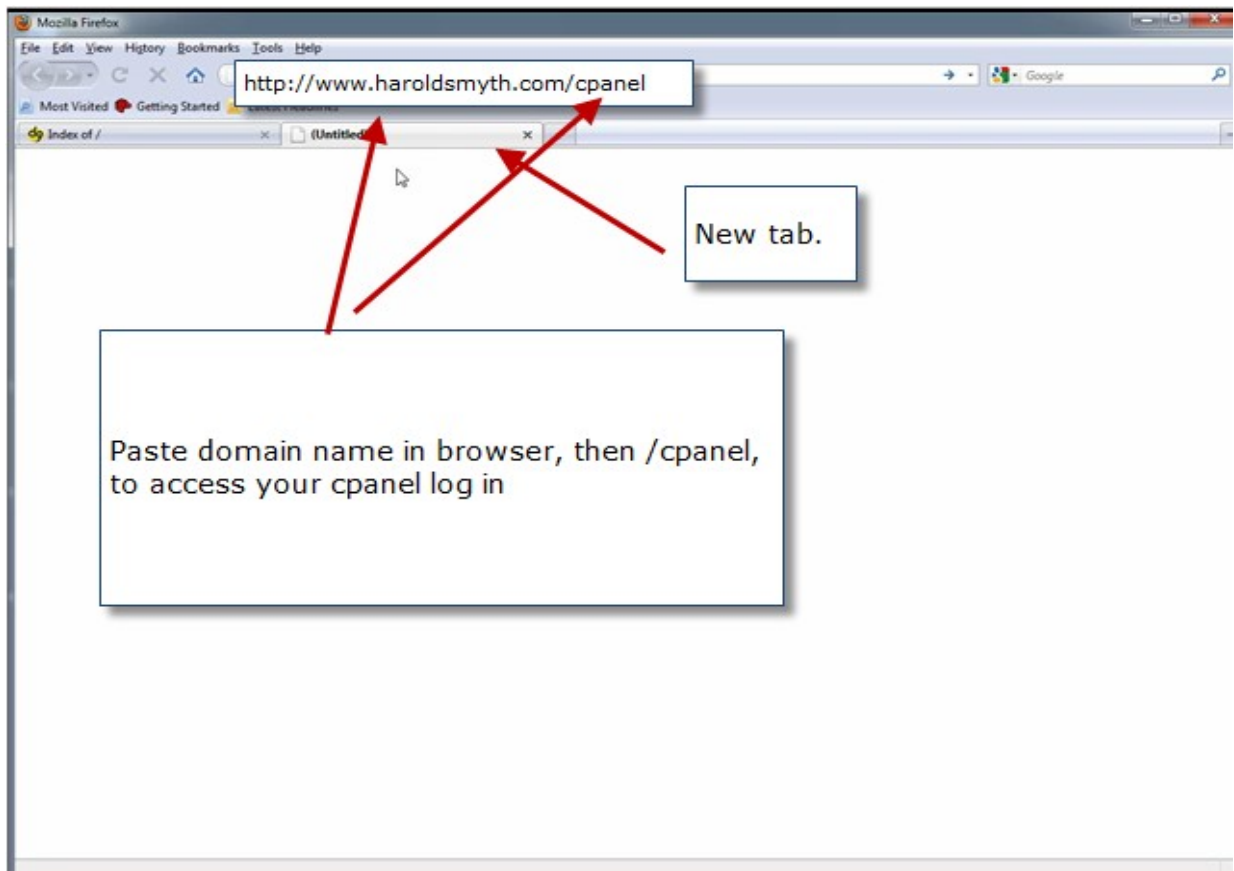
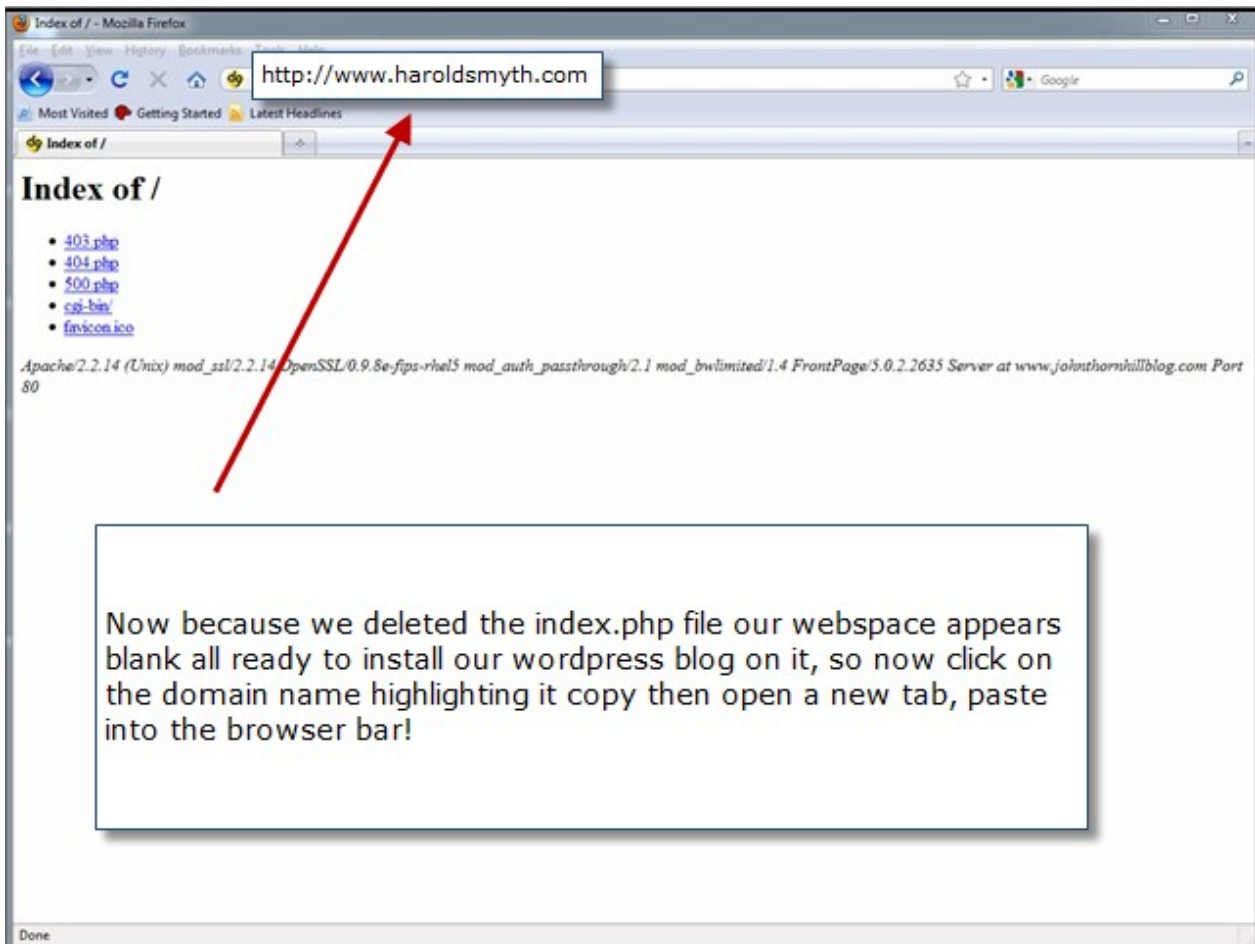
BUT you have to make sure you have selected the right folder location to upload to first on your webspace first !

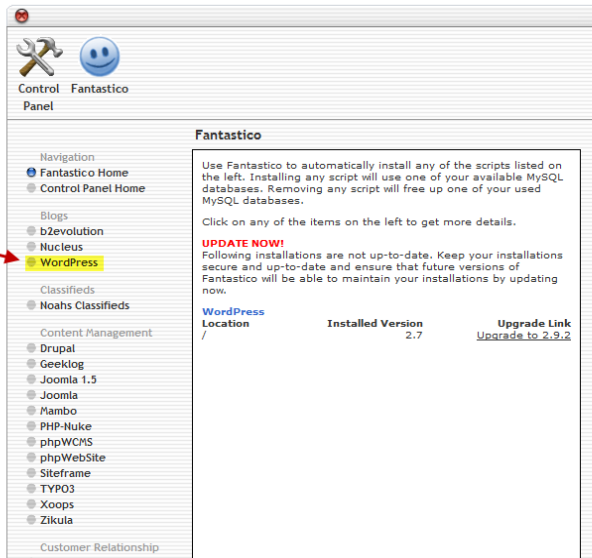

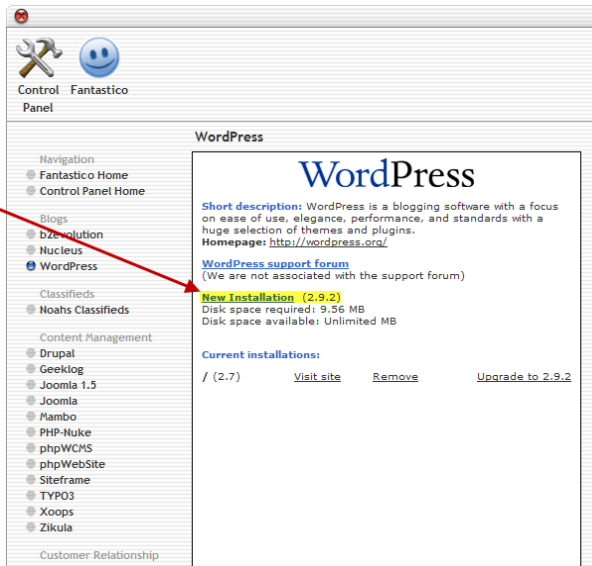

Copy and paste domain name into the description box!

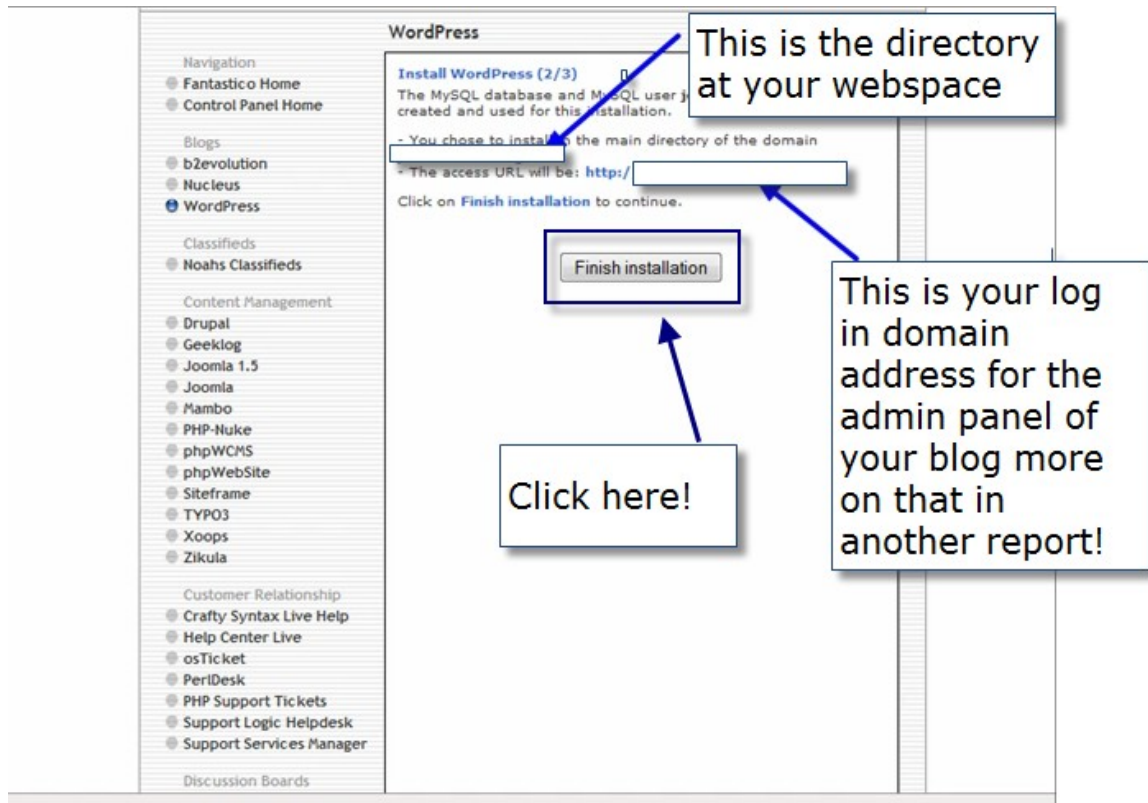
Now simply click here!



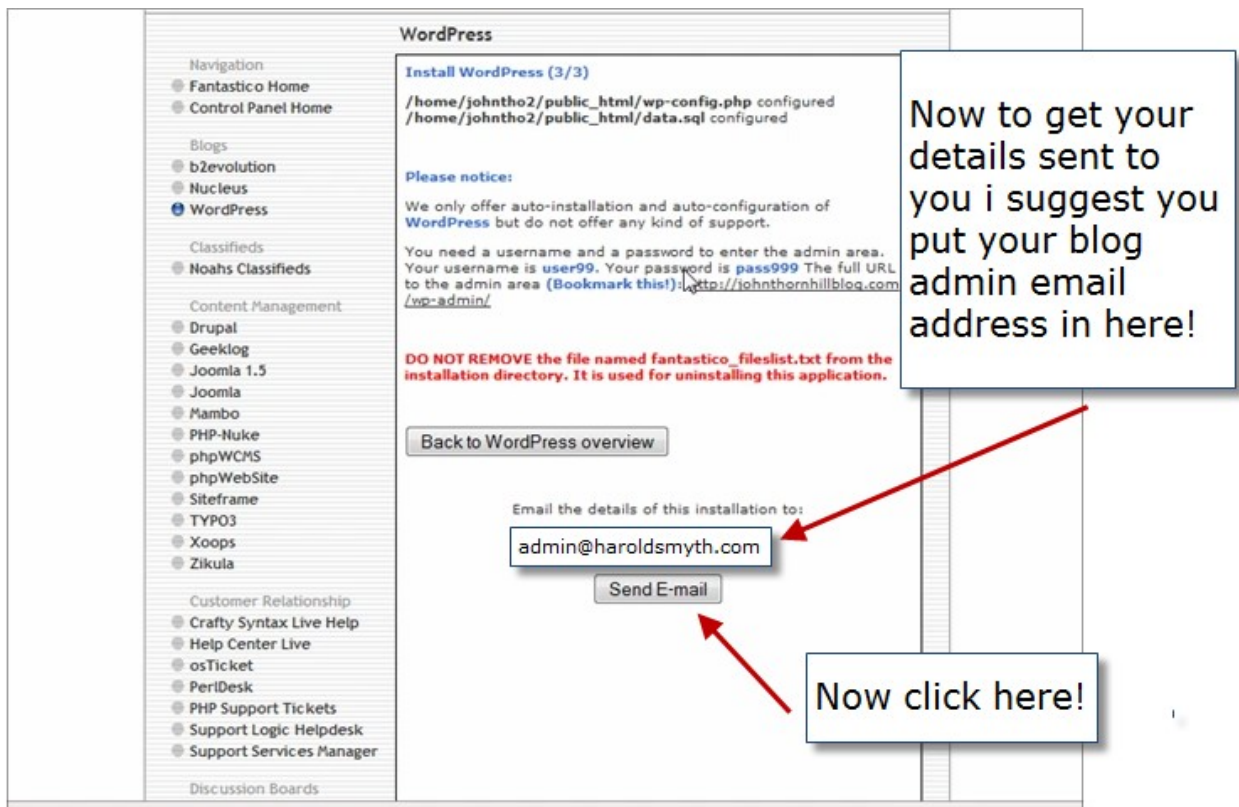
Here just put anything you want for your nickname and password but make a note of them so you don't forget them!

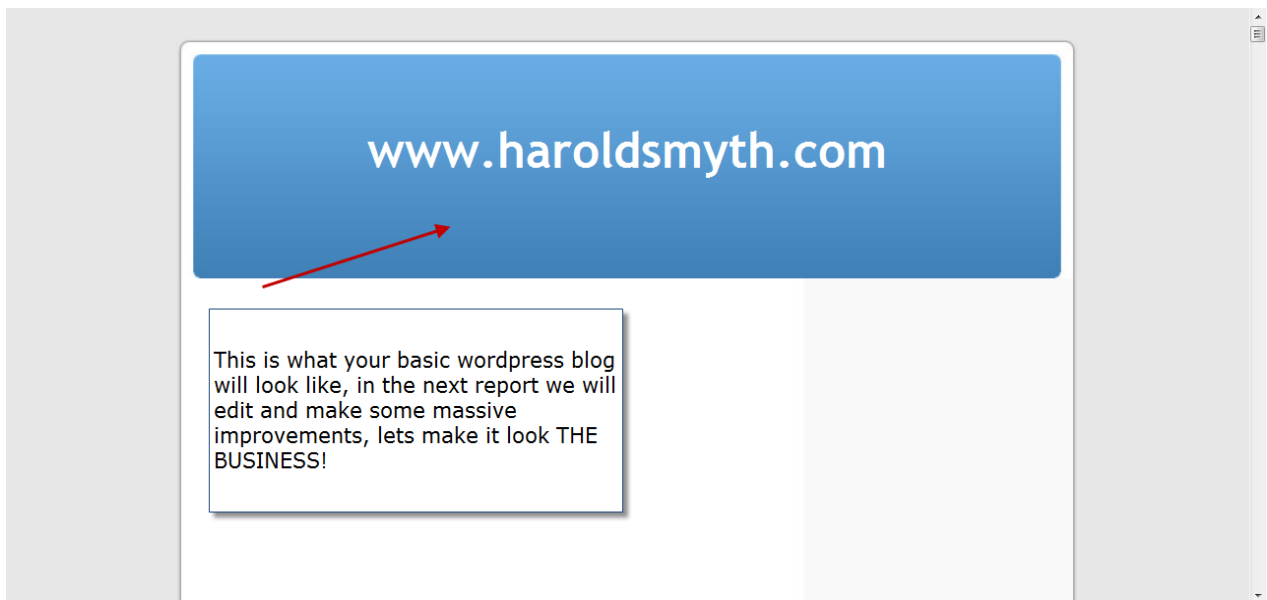
Again put your nickname here!
